Most Advanced Trauma Resuscitation Workshop For Emergency, Critical Care & Anaesthesia Specialists *First-of-its-kind in India, in our city Hyderabad*

Care Institute of Health Sciences (CIHS), The Alfred Health – Monash University, Australia (World's Best Emergency & Trauma Centre) and the Society For Emergency Medicine India Conducts "Trauma Resuscitation Workshop" for Emergency Medicine, Critical Care & Anaesthesia Specialists with Hands-on Practice on High Fidelity MANIKINS and CADAVERS for the first time in Hyderabad.

Hyderabad, 15th September 2018: Prof. Peter Cameron, Academic Director of The Alfred Emergency and Trauma Center, Australia, Care Institute of Health Sciences (CIHS) and Society for Emergency Medicine India conducted a first-of-its-kind **Trauma Resuscitation Workshop** for providing Specialists in Emergency Medicine, Critical Care and Anaesthesia hands-on training in Advanced Emergency Procedures on 14th and 15th September 2018, in the presence of Dr. B. Soma Raju, Chairman, Care Institute of Health Sciences.

The sessions had a **very focussed group of 24 participants (Heads of Departments) from Emergency Medicine, Critical Care & Anaesthesia from premier institutions across India.** On the occasion, Care Institute of Health Sciences (CIHS) and Alfred Health – Monash University, Australia launched **four specialised courses** for doctors and the nursing fraternity.

Briefing the media, Prof Peter Cameron asked, as an Emergency doctor how do you train for urgent life-threatening interventions that cannot wait for specialised help but are rarely encountered in your supervised training? To address this need, the workshop included advanced procedures such as Surgical Airway (Cricothyroidotomy), Orbital Decompression (Lateral Canthotomy and Cantholysis), Pericardial Decompression including Resuscitative Thoracotomy, Pleural Decompression (Finger Thoracotomy and Pleural Drainage), Vascular Access, Temporary Trans-venous Cardiac Pacing and Retrieval Limb Amputation.

The two-day course provided candidates the knowledge and practical experience required to perform emergency surgical procedures in the emergency department or in a pre-hospital setting.

An international faculty from The Alfred Emergency & Trauma Centre, Australia, facilitated the course, in collaboration with faculty from the Care Institute of Health Sciences and Society of Emergency Medicine India.

Dr. B. Soma Raju, Chairman, Care Institute of Health Sciences said the trauma resuscitation workshop was aimed at practicing doctors to provide hands-on experience in managing basic and complex resuscitative procedures in critical areas. Following training on cadavers, the participants reinforced the training by practising on high-fidelity manikins at the state-of-the-art Safercare Simulation Lab. This training offers national and international validation due to its high standards and the presence of master trainers.

Fellowship in Emergency Medicine	Advanced training program for doctors in clinical management & research
Clinical Educator Program	Leadership training for experienced doctors to expand knowledge and training skills to become a core faculty member

Students will be enrolled from across the Indian health system sector. Students for each training program would be divided into learning groups of 30-50 per course. The programs are designed in a manner that would facilitate the retention of students in the healthcare system by ensuring that the training is contextually relevant to the Indian setting.
